A vote of thanks was given to the officers and members who had served on the committee and those who had agreed to serve for 1981/82.

9. Planning 1981/82

Mr Williams suggested that a Scorers Award Course should be run. Mr Jones hoped that each local area would appoint an officials secretary - this could then make the organisation of local scorers and officials courses much easier.

Mr Richards offered to run a scorers award course at Whitefield tournament on Saturday July 18th. Mr Richards spoke of the suggestions by Sports Council that grant aid to governing bodies for employment of staff will be cut over a 3 year period from 75% to 50%. He believed that this might have a drastic effect on regional finance. Mr Brehaut spoke of the need to take care on finance.

Mr Mosley would like to make a careful plan of the needs of the region for coaching courses and would like to hear from any area with particular needs.

Mr Spear asked Mrs Sessions if the lack of Junior Development was due to lack of money. She felt it was not the lack of money but generally lack of effort on the part of clubs to set up junior sections and make contact with schools. Mr Jones emphasised the need to work with Youth Clubs.
