Mr Richards congratulated Avon on the organisation of the first properly constituted county association in the S.W.

Miss Kelman noted the increase in the number of ladies teams - particularly in the Weymouth league.

Mr Richards asked areas to send minutes of local meetings.

Development had also taken place in Barnstaple and in Cornwall and it was hoped to have further reports at the next meeting.

11. Grant Aid

Bids were received from Poole, Swindon, Avon and Stroud.

Agreed to grant £40 to Avon and £50 to Swindon. As no representative was present from Poole or Stroud their applications were held over.

Concern was shown that many of the applications were for running costs and not for development. Areas were to be asked to account for the spending of their grant aid.

12. Commonwealth Games

Discussion was held over until the afternoon meeting.

13. Major Events

Spring Cup - decision to be made at the afternoon meeting.

County Cup - Mr Richards to suggest to Wilts/Glos that they might like to bid for 1983 County Cup finals.

Internationals - agreed to support local bids (e.g. Stroud) as long as it involved the Sw in no expenditure

No strong feelings expressed except from Mr Moss who was dissatisfied with Portsmouth's position re the Southern region.
